Unit, Research Results Regulations for Rewarding

- Article 1 In order to enhance the dissemination and publication of academic research results by full-time faculty members and researchers within the institution. National Chengchi University (NCCU)has formulated the regulation for rewarding research units for their research results.
- Article 2 For the research results published or issued by full-time faculty members and researchers within the institution, with the unit specified as the NCCU and approved by the respective college (or research center), applications for awards may be submitted to the college(or research center) once per academic year in accordance with these regulations. Each research result may only apply for an award once. The term "research results" as referred to in these regulations includes the following:
 - 1. Journal articles published in academic or professional journals with a review system (including those with formal review procedures and electronic journals that are open and accessible).
 - 2. Academic monographs or textbooks and their chapters published after review and made publicly available.
 - 3. Other research results recognized by the respective college (or research center).

Acceptance of journal articles is considered publication, and applications may only be submitted for academic monographs or textbooks and their chapters after publication. This does not include articles published in collected works, conference proceedings, or edited books.

Article 3 Each college (or research center) shall establish detailed regulations for the review of award-winning research results in accordance with these regulations. These regulations should include the items and criteria for awards, and they should be submitted to the University's Research and Development Conference for reference. Each college (or research center) should convene a meeting to review the applications.

The list of award recipients should be confirmed online by each

college (or research center) before the end of each academic year, and a printed copy should be submitted to the NCCU's Office of Research and Development for reference.

- Article 4 The annual allocation of award money to each college (or research center) is calculated based on the previous year's National Science and Technology Council (hereinafter referred to as the NSTC) projects, non-NSTC projects, the number of research award recipients, and the number of formally published academic books after review. The details of the calculation method for award allocation are as follows:
 - A. The execution rate of NSTC projects by each college or research center in the preceding year.
 - B. The execution rate of non-NSTC projects by each college or research center in the preceding year.
 - C. The weight of the number of research award recipients by each college or research center in the preceding year = (Total number of research award recipients by each college or research center in the preceding year / Total number of research award recipients for the entire school in the preceding year) *100%
 - D. The weight of the number of academic books (by each college or research center) in the preceding year = (Number of academic books by each college or research center in the preceding year / Total number of academic books for the entire school in the preceding year) *100%
 - E. The allocation ratio of prize money to each unit =(A*40%) +(B*10%) +(C*40%) +(D*10%)
 - F. The allocated prize money for each college or research center = Current year budget $\times E$
- Article 5 The allocation of award funds shall be granted by each college(or research center)in accordance with the list of award recipients and relevant accounting regulations.
- Article 6 The expenses required by these regulations shall be funded by the selfgenerated income of the NCCU's general funds.
- Article 7 These regulations shall be implemented following approval by the conference of NCCU's Office of Research and Development and the NCCU's general funds committee. Amendments shall follow the same process.
