4. The roles of Taiwanese and Israeli partners in carrying out the proposed research plan should be indicated, and the mode of integrating the work of the teams should be described.
5. Description of available research resources, including short CV's of research team members and inventory of relevant equipment.
6. Bibliography of relevant literature.
7. Letter of Agreement for the cooperation for all P.I.s
