

## National Chengchi University Table of Fixed Subsidies for Paper Presentation at International Conferences

Passed on October 15, 2015 during the 53rd Research and Development Meeting of the Office of Research and Development

### Important information:

- I. Faculty members and students attending international academic conferences to present their papers must submit their applications for subsidies to the Ministry of Science and Technology in advance, except for those who have received subsidies from the ministry in the same year and are therefore not eligible to apply for additional subsidies. Those who are attending international academic conferences to present their papers the second time in the same year (including the attendance of international academic conferences using MOST Academic Research Programs budget subsidies) and are therefore ineligible for MOST subsidies may provide the MOST letter of approval or a list of payments from the previous subsidies and apply for fixed subsidies from the Office of Research and Development.
- II. Applicants who have not received subsidies or fail to submit applications to the Ministry of Science and Technology by respective deadlines for reasons not attributable to the applicants may apply, with the appropriate documents and proofs, for subsidies at a fixed ratio of 50% from NCCU.
- III. Those who have received off-campus subsidies may not apply for full amount subsidies or the shortfall from NCCU.
