Articles 1 and 4

- The guidelines are established by National Chengchi University (hereinafter referred to as NCCU) to encourage new faculty and researchers at NCCU to apply for research projects funded by <u>National Science and Technology Council</u> (hereinafter referred to as "<u>NSTC</u>").
- 2. New faculty or researchers may submit a proposal for a research project funding subsidy to the Office of Research and Development (hereinafter referred to as, "ORD") after reporting for duty and before the end of the semester. The Vice President for Research and Development is authorized to approve the applications.

3. Subsidy items:

(1) The upper limit of subsidy granted hereunder isNT\$100,000, with a maximum subsidy duration of 10 months. The subsidy period begins once the applicant receives the application approval notification. Items that may be covered by this subsidy include assistant fees, work-study allowances, domestic and overseas travel expenses, and the purchase of research equipment, books, consumables,

and miscellaneous expenses related to the project.

- (2) Applicants may invite a senior professor or researcher with outstanding research performance (either inside or outside the school) to serve as a consultant for their project. Invited consultants will be paid NT\$10,000 per case.
- 4. Faculty and researchers who receive the subsidy must submit a concise report (3-5 pages) to ORD within one month after the subsidy period ends. Additionally, they must apply for an <u>NSTC</u> research project during the next application period.
- 5. The funds required for the subsidies due hereunder are covered by income coming from NCCU's tuition and miscellaneous fees, and self-financing from the Endowment Fund Item 5.
- 6. These rules shall be implemented following approval by the R&D Meeting and the University Fund Management Committee. The same procedure applies to any amendments.
